**ORDER FOR PLAINTIFF'S *EX PARTE* MOTION  
TO EXTEND THE TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER, CONTINUE THE ORDER  
TO SHOW CAUSE HEARING, AND MODIFY SCHEDULE**

On this day the Court considered Plaintiff's *Ex Parte* Motion to Extend the Temporary Restraining Order, Continue the Order to Show Cause Hearing, and Modify Schedule. Having reviewed the Motion with supporting legal authority, and the April 26, 2019 Declaration of Brian Samuel Malkin, the same having established that good cause exists for granting Plaintiff's Application, Plaintiff's Application is hereby **GRANTED** as follows (the "Order"):

**ORDER**

A. Defendants are hereby ORDERED to show cause before this Court in the United States District Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania, the U.S. Courthouse, 700 Grant Street, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania in Courtroom No. 8A on the **20th day of May, 2019, at 10:30 a.m.** or at such other time that this Court deems appropriate, why a preliminary injunction, pursuant to FRCP 65(a), should not issue. The Temporary Restraining Order (ECF No. 11) shall remain in effect until further Order of this Court.

B. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that opposing papers, if any, shall be filed electronically with the Court and served on Rapid Slicer's counsel by delivering copies thereof to the office of Ference & Associates LLC at 409 Broad Street, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania 15143 before **May 15, 2019**. Rapid Slicer shall file any Reply papers on or before **May 17, 2019**.

C. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, as sufficient cause has been shown, service shall be made in accordance with the Alternative Service Order (ECF No. 12) within five (5) days of the Financial Institutions' and Third Party Service Providers' compliance with Paragraphs I and III of the April 15, 2019 Order (ECF No. 11). Plaintiff shall also serve a copy of this Order upon Defendants when service by Alternative means is made.
