ALTERNATIVE SERVICE AND (2) DEEMING SERVICE
ACCOMPLISHED UPON CERTAIN DEFENDANTS

AND NOW, this 16th October day of ~~September~~, 2019, the Court having considered Plaintiffs'

Motion for an Order (1) amending the Court's June 27, 2019, Order authorizing service of process on certain defendants to include additional defendants and (2) deeming the electronic service of the Complaint and Summons made upon all defendants as service upon certain defendants, along with the legal authorities and evidence submitted therewith. Upon consideration, it is hereby ordered that Plaintiffs' Motion is GRANTED as follows:

The Alternative Service Order (ECF No. 17) is amended so that Plaintiffs are authorized to make alternative service of the Summonses, the Complaint, any discovery, and all filings in this matter upon Defendants 4dice_international, ricji-45, us2014.runzh, daos_34, gohastings, ljsuperiorchew, pege-318, raysal_64, and vestut-56 in this action, as follows:

1. via e-mail by providing the address to Plaintiffs' designated website to Defendants via (i) the e-mail accounts provided by Defendants as part of the data related to their respective e-commerce stores, or (ii) the e-commerce marketplace for each of the e-commerce stores, or

2. via website publication by posting copies of the Summonses, Complaint, any Discovery, and all filings in this matter on Plaintiffs' designated website on www.ferencelaw.com.

Defendants 4dice_international, ricji-45, us2014.runzh, daos_34, gohastings, ljsuperiorchew, pege-318, raysal_64, and vestut-56, having previously been provided a copy of the Summons and Complaint by both e-mail and publication, service of process is deemed accomplished as to these Defendants and Plaintiffs shall file a *Summons/Return of Service Return Executed* indicating that these Defendants have been served with the Summons and Complaint.
