**ORDER FOR PLAINTIFFS' *EX PARTE* MOTION
TO EXTEND THE TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER, CONTINUE THE ORDER
TO SHOW CAUSE HEARING, AND MODIFY SCHEDULE**

On this day the Court considered Plaintiffs' *Ex Parte* Motion to Extend the Temporary Restraining Order, Continue the Order to Show Cause Hearing, and Modify Schedule. Having reviewed the Motion with supporting legal authority, and the January 3, 2020 Declaration of Brian Samuel Malkin, the same having established that good cause exists for granting Plaintiffs' Application, Plaintiffs' Application is hereby **GRANTED** as follows (the "Order"):

ORDER

A. Defendants are hereby ORDERED to show cause before this Court in the United States District Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania, the U.S. Courthouse, 700 Grant Street, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania in Courtroom No. 6A on the 21st day of January, 2020, at 9:30 a.m. or at such other time that this Court deems appropriate, why a preliminary injunction, pursuant to FRCP 65(a), should not issue. The Temporary Restraining Order (ECF No. 19) shall remain in effect until 12:00 p.m. on January 23, 2020.

B. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that opposing papers, if any, shall be filed electronically with the Court and served on Plaintiffs' counsel by delivering copies thereof to the office of Ference & Associates LLC at 409 Broad Street, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania 15143 before January 13, 2020. Plaintiffs shall file any Reply papers on or before 12:00 p.m. on January 17, 2020.

C. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, as sufficient cause has been shown, service shall be made in accordance with the Alternative Service Order (ECF No. 19) within twenty-four (24) hours after Amazon's confirms that court-ordered restraints have been placed on the Defendants' accounts and Plaintiffs shall file notice of such confirmation on the docket under seal without the need for redaction. Plaintiffs shall also serve a copy of this Order upon Defendants when service by Alternative means is made.
