## **ORDER SETTING HEARING AND CONTINUING INJUNCTIVE RELIEF**

Defendants shall show cause before this Court in the United States District Court for the Western District of Pennsylvania, the U.S. Courthouse, 700 Grant Street, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania in Courtroom No. 6A on the 11th day of February, 2020, at 3:15p.m. EST or at such other time that this Court deems appropriate, why a preliminary injunction, pursuant to FRCP 65(a), should not issue, and Plaintiffs shall demonstrate on the record why the entry of such relief is legally and factually appropriate. **Defendants are on notice that failure to appear at the hearing may result in the imposition of a preliminary injunction against them.** 

Opposing papers, if any, shall be filed electronically with the Court and served on Plaintiffs' counsel by delivering copies thereof to the office of Ference & Associates LLC at 409 Broad Street, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania 15143 before February 4, 2020. Plaintiffs shall file any Reply papers on or before February 7, 2020.

The Temporary Restraining Order previously issued will remain in effect until the conclusion of the hearing as set forth above, or until such further dates as set by the Court or

stipulated by the parties. The Court notes extending the Temporary Restraining Order will permit the parties additional time to prepare for the hearing to show cause and the Temporary Restraining Order does not merely provide a terse explanation for the reasons the restraint was entered, but includes both findings of fact and conclusions of law.

Plaintiffs' counsel shall serve a copy of this Order upon all Defendants in accordance with the Alternative Service Order (ECF No. 19), upon any counsel that may have contacted Plaintiffs' counsel, and shall thereafter file proof of service.
