B. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that opposing papers, if any, shall be filed electronically
with the Court and served on Plaintiffs' counsel by delivering copies thereof to the office of
Ference & Associates LLC at 409 Broad Street, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania 15143 before
, 2019. Plaintiffs shall file any Reply papers on or before,
2019.
C. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, as sufficient cause has been shown, service shall be
made in accordance with the Alternative Service Order (ECF No. 19) within twenty four hours
after Amazon's confirms that court-ordered restraints have been placed on the Defendants'
accounts and Plaintiffs shall file notice of such confirmation on the docket under seal without the
need for redaction. Plaintiffs shall also serve a copy of this Order upon Defendants when service
by Alternative means is made.
