**[PROPOSED] ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO AMEND FINAL DEFAULT  
JUDGMENT AND PERMANENT INJUNCTION**

This matter comes before the Court upon Plaintiff, Airigan Solutions, LLC's ("Plaintiff") to Amend Default Judgment and Permanent Injunction ("the Final Judgment") [ECF No. 52] to Include Defendant No. 26 SITELLY.

This Court has reviewed the Motion and pertinent portions of the record and is otherwise fully advised of the supporting facts and law.

The Court previously entered the Final Judgment against the defaulting defendants on August 13, 2019 [ECF No. 52]. Plaintiff however had not requested entry of default or entry of the default judgment against Defendant No. 26 SITELLY because they were negotiating a settlement at the time of entry of default. They failed to reach a settlement, however, and now Plaintiff seeks to amend the Final Judgment to include Defendant No. 26 SITELLY. At no time has SITELLY appeared in this action. It did not respond to the Amended Complaint, move to vacate the default, or oppose Plaintiff's motion for the final default judgment and permanent

injunction. Accordingly, the Court amends the Final Judgment to include this Defendant. It is, therefore, hereby

ORDERED that the Motion to Amend the Final Judgment and Permanent Injunction is GRANTED. Plaintiff is entitled to a Final Judgment against Defendant No. 26 SITELLY. The Court will separately enter an amended Final Default Judgment and Permanent Injunction, which shall list Defendant No. 26 SITELLY in Schedule "A".
